A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE SUMMER WOODS COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT DESIGNATING THE PRIMARY ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICE AND PRINCIPAL HEADQUARTERS OF THE DISTRICT AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Summer Woods Community Development District (the "District") is a local unit of special-purpose government created and existing pursuant to Chapter 190, *Florida Statutes*, being situated entirely within Manatee County, Florida; and

WHEREAS, the District desires to designate its primary administrative office as the location where the District's public records are routinely created, sent, received, maintained, and requested, for the purposes of prominently posting the contact information of the District's Record's Custodian in order to provide citizens with the ability to access the District's records and ensure that the public is informed of the activities of the District in accordance with Chapter 119, *Florida Statutes*; and

WHEREAS, the District additionally desires to specify the location of the District's principal headquarters for the purpose of establishing proper venue under the common law home venue privilege applicable to the District.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE SUMMER WOODS COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT:

SECTION 1. The District's primary administrative office for purposes of Chapter 119, Florida Statutes, shall be located at Rizzetta & Company, Inc., 9428 Camden Field Parkway, Riverview, Florida 33578.

SECTION 2. The District's principal headquarters for purposes of establishing proper venue shall be located at the Trevesta Clubhouse, 6210 Trevesta Place, Palmetto, Florida 34221 within Manatee County, Florida.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
